The CGC is the equivalent of a HS diploma in the dog world. You wouldn't want your pup to enter the big world without this minimum requirement. AKC Good Citizens (CGC) & Therapy Certifications (THC)

We're city folk and our dogs live in urban environments where we like to have our dogs with us as much as possible. That calls for a new set of rules, where dogs must behave amongst people and can't go sniffing every person or pup they see. As a matter of fact, that behavior would create chaos.

The AKC recognized this years ago and came up with their Canine Good Citizen (CGC) program, that has now expanded from Star Puppy to include an Urban, Advanced and Community Good Citizen. These certifications are a direct line to becoming an AKC Therapy Dog, where you can bring your dog into hospitals, homecare facilities, hospice and other senior care homes to share the comfort of your well-behaved dog who can bring moments of cheerfulness to an aging or lonely individual.

That does not mean your dog can go to grocery stores or restaurants! But he can come to the bank, to your club meetings and other occasions where food is not a primary service and he behaves as a CGC graduate, with a vest and papers, at your side and non-invasive with other people or dogs.

These classes are offered 7 days a week on a 1:1 basis, depending on the level of your dog's previous training status, when not training agility. Training starts at three-\$40 lessons or \$120, and may include as many as 12 lessons. You can stop at any time if not satisfied with the progress. Lessons may be at facilities around the Napa Valley in order to expose your dog to real life situations with meeting new people and dogs in new environments. Some classroom time is involved. At times you may be training with up to two other dogs. You can sign up by phone with CC or Venmo.



I will continue to teach tricks and show, and organize trials in between agility and CGC. We want to stay active in all aspects helping you become the best dog companion your pet could ever hope for!

I will continue training AKC Tricks, Show Ring, Leash Manners, Puppy Classes and some special needs care for frightened rescue dogs. I'll be competing my dog, Nitro, in shows, organizing trips to trials, and holding special seminars throughout the year.
